From the Turf Care Center

WOW, Mother Nature loves us right now. The weather has been incredible this winter with minimal frost days and no hard frost at all. This helps both the over-seeded and non-over-seeded turf areas. The over-seeded grass has continued to grow throughout the winter, and the non-over-seeded grass will not have much of a winter set back and should come back nicely. It should be a great spring golf season.

Our main focus has been on course conditioning and daily course set-up. Our goal is to provide the best possible playing conditions every day and be tournament ready at all times.

We continue to make improvements as time allows. We have finished painting the restroom floors making them as good as any golf course restrooms can be. We finished repairing and painting the block wall on 10/17 Canyons ask everyone to be careful in this area with traffic coming from all direction. We continue to trim and clean bushes, trees, DG Beds, and etc. as time allows. Neat, clean and detailed is our goal.

We are starting a new section from the Turf Care Center called the WHY section. WHY do we do what we do? After 45 years in the business I have had a lot of WHY'S. I encourage members to reach out and ask WHY. Hopefully this will help provide accurate information during the 19th hole sessions that everyone enjoys after a round of golf.

2 WHY'S this month.

WHY don't they cut the bushes down on holes 5, 6, and 8 Palmer so my ball will roll down into the fairway? From a maintenance perspective these bushes provide excellent erosion control from wind, rain and nightly irrigation. It is very noticeable on hole 5 of the Palmer where there are no bushes and we see erosion onto the turf areas. From a golfing perspective those who hit it in the fairway should be rewarded and those who don't should practice more. This makes golf great.

WHY don't they allow golf carts on hole #1 on both courses? From a maintenance and golf perspective the grass is better with no traffic. The turf conditions improved and so did the playability. It is nice for our members and guests to start out the day on well groomed conditions. And, a little walk is good for all of us. Win - Win for everyone.


The OWGA is excited to continue our spring season with great tournaments and lots of fun!

However, we have encountered an unintended issue. When tee times are canceled online the day before play — particularly on days when we have a scheduled Member Shotgun — those times automatically become available to outside play. As a result, we have had outside players booked into tee times that overlap with our Member Shotgun starts. This has significantly slowed down play during these events and created avoidable congestion on the course.

If you are scheduled to play in a Member Shotgun and need to cancel your tee time, we kindly ask that you please call the Pro Shop directly rather than canceling online. This allows our staff to properly adjust and block those times to prevent outside bookings from interfering with the shotgun start.


